1. Any act of indiscipline, teasing, or handling with rudeness.
2. Any act that prevents or disrupts regular academic activity.
3. Any activity likely to cause annoyance, hardship, psychological harm, fear, or apprehension.
4. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure.
5. Any act of physical abuse causing assault, harm, or danger to health.
6. Any act of abuse through spoken words, emails, SMS, or public insults.
7. Any act of injury or infringement of fundamental human dignity.
8. Any act of wrongful confinement, kidnapping, molesting, or committing unnatural offenses, use of criminal forces, trespass, or intimidation.
9. Any unlawful assembly or conspiracy to engage in ragging.

The vision of anti-ragging initiatives is to create a sensitive and responsible atmosphere among students regarding the consequences of engaging in ragging.

The mission of the Anti-Ragging Committee is to ensure compliance with regulations and laws related to ragging. The committee also monitors and oversees the Anti-Ragging Squad's performance in preventing ragging on the institution's premises.
